



Founded in 1928, [Austin Sunshine Camps](#) (ASC) provides FREE overnight camp for youth who receive free/reduced lunch and youth in foster care. We believe in the power of summer camp, and we believe that your ability to go to camp shouldn't be determined by how much money your family makes. Camp is held for 4 sessions of 10 days and 9 nights each. Summer staff have training and cleaning on the afternoon of day 10, and days 11-14 are off!

ASC has two beautiful, unique camp locations:

- Located in the beautiful Turkey Bend Recreation Area in Marble Falls, [Lake Travis](#) offers a rustic setting for up to 55 campers each session, ages 12-15. Campers have the opportunity to swim in the lake, explore the hill country, play a variety of sports and games, experience our high ropes course and more.
- [Zilker Lodge](#) provides an amazing urban oasis for up to 80 participants each session, ages 8-11. Campers have the opportunity to explore Zilker Park, canoe on Lady Bird Lake, hike on the Greenbelt, make a variety of crafts, experience our challenge course and more.

About the Role

At Austin Sunshine Camps, we focus on creating an environment where our campers can **GROW, CONNECT, and EXPLORE** across lines of difference, and we can't do this work without having healthy campers. The Camp Health Officer is the most crucial player in ensuring our kids and staff stay healthy at camp! This role has developed an increasing importance, and is a crucial part of the team that ensures safety and wellness for all campers and staff.

The Camp Health Officer provides first aid care for campers and staff, oversees the administration of medications to campers and staff, coordinates visits to a physician when needed, monitors health and cleanliness standards, organizes paperwork and maintains file organization. The important work of the Camp Health Officer includes monitoring and evaluating camp procedures, facilities, and conditions and suggesting modifications that would create more healthful conditions at camp.

Requirements

- You are a registered nurse or licensed vocational nurse (preferred)
- You have an American Red Cross Emergency Response certificate (required if not an RN or LVN)
- You have pediatric and/or previous camp nursing experience (preferred)
- You have the ability to drive a camp vehicle to transport campers to emergency treatment
- You have the ability to pass a national criminal background check
- You have the ability to life or assist campers or staff
- You keep neat and orderly records
- You're able to stay on site while camp is in session (including overnights)

You're Excited About Us Because

- Dependent on level of certification and prior experience, stipend of \$150-\$170/day, (~\$7,000-\$8,000 for full summer or ~\$3,500-\$4,000 for half summer), pre-tax, plus all meals/snacks provided while camp is in session
- Free lodging (either at Zilker Lodge or our Lake Travis location), including 4 days off in between camp sessions and an 11-day mid-summer break
